Dear Parents/Guardians:

The School Health Law requires all children to have a dental examination upon initial entry into school (kindergarten or first grade). Additional dental screenings are required in grade three and seven. Although these examinations may be carried out by the health services staff of the school district, there are advantages to having them completed by your family dentist. They know the past dental history of your child and are best able to recommend any remedial care which may be needed. In addition, examinations by your family dentist ensure continuity in dental care, which cannot be secured through examinations provided in school.

Should the forms not be signed and returned to the school, the dental examinations will be done during the school year.
